



Group Programmes at Jesters Flat

Jesters Flat welcomes group bookings from all sections of the community.

Since its inception, Jesters Flat has hosted a range of group horse riding activities simply tailored to suit!

Over the years we have provided group entertainment for events as diverse as these....

- School excursions
- Scout troupes
- Birthday celebrations
- Childrens pony parties
- Girls weekends
- Hens parties
- School holiday program events
- Workplace Personal Development
- Sporting Club celebrations

The program features are suitable to combine over a few hours or a couple of days.

Costs vary dependant on activities and length of time, starting at \$50 through to \$150 per person. We're happy to negotiate further for Not For Profit organizations.

Generally we accept groups of up to 20 horse riders at one time, although other non- riders and support crew may attend free of charge.

So first let's look at a **sample half day** event valued at \$55pp (20 people horseriding):

Before the Event

The group receives confirmation of all activities and is required to pay 50% deposit. Jesters Flat provides a receipt and a copy of our insurance Certificate of Currency.

On the Day

9.45am Group meets at Jesters Flat cottage for welcome and briefing. Helmets and boots fitted. Disclaimer forms signed. Group is divided into two sections.

First group heads out into the forest for a one hour trail ride.

Second group has a one hour horsemanship lesson including basic animal husbandry, saddlery, introduction to current stud foals, polocrosse basics, whip cracking.

11.30 Groups swap over activities.

12.45 Both groups join at Jesters Flat cottage with support crew for Sausage sizzle and drinks. Marshmallow toasting around the campfire during winter.

2.00pm Event finishes.

After the Event

Activities available:

- Forest trail ride
- Drivers trail ride across 500 acres of the working cattle farm.
- Horsemanship lessons, including basic animal husbandry
- Whip cracking practise
- Polocrosse basics, on the ground and on horseback
- Bush walking
- Group BBQ and camping.

Facilities available:

- Reception Cottage with undercover area seating 20people, additional seating available.
- Treehouse seating 10 people
- Campfire with log seating during cooler months
- Large ablution block including showers
- BBQ and preparation tables
- Camping area
- Railway carriage camp area
